YOUTH DEVELOPMENT FOR EDUCATION RESULTS WORK GROUP

Purpose: The Youth Development for Education Results Work Group will support the efforts of the Road Map Project where youth serving community organizations play an integral role.

- Develop an **action plan** to support stronger partnerships between youth serving CBOs and schools including:
 - Supporting effective **data sharing** and **use**
 - Advancing regional efforts to **measure and improve student engagement and motivation**
 - Supporting **CBO alignment** with RMP goals and indicators
 - **Increasing programs** and services after-school and in the summer

Rethinking How Students Succeed – Article & Series of Responses in SSIR:

Four pathways to develop many more effective learners

COLLABORATIONS BETWEEN RESEARCHERS AND TEACHERS

Classroom-based research initiatives that seek to identify teaching practices that support students to develop as effective learners through rapid cycles of experimentation and feedback

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR TEACHERS

Integrating noncognitive competencies into current forms of professional development provided to teachers

SYSTEMIC REFORMS IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Supporting school districts to integrate noncognitive competencies into district-level policies and practices, extending to every classroom

COMPLEMENTARY EFFORTS BETWEEN IN-SCHOOL AND AFTER-SCHOOL OR EXPANDED LEARNING TIME

After-school or expanded learning time programs that already focus on noncognitive development working more closely with their partner schools

Two priorities for moving forward

SHIFT FROM
REPLICATION
OF PROGRAMS TO
INTEGRATION OF PRACTICES
INTO DAILY INTERACTIONS
WITH STUDENTS

- Over the past two decades, dozens of SEL programs have been developed; many of these are taught as add-ons
- Going forward, advocates want to see SEL and academic behaviors become integral to the student experience, and they want to achieve this shift on a scale that reaches millions of students

HELP EDUCATORS
CHANGE THEIR OWN
BELIEFS AND MINDSETS

- Students can't develop as effective learners unless their teachers understand and model the skills and behaviors they are supposed to teach
- Educators not only feel unfamiliar with noncognitive skills and unprepared to teach them; in many cases, they also need to change long-held beliefs in their own and their students' capacity to learn
