- 4-week Boot Camp: 1 cohort/year: diploma or GED required, driver's license required, strong work history required, some construction training preferred.
- Try Outs: Candidates must try out to get into class:
 - 2 weeks before start of class.
 - Drug (UA) test, interview, hands-on assessment.

Our program includes, proper hand tool and power tool use, industrial safety and trades math. In addition graduating students will have the opportunity to earn OSHA 10, First Aid, CPR.

You will also receive Flagging Certification after passing your final test and Forklift Operation Certification after passing the written and driving tests. These classes are part of our PACT program and may also be taken individually.

YOUTH CARE'S YOUTHBUILD

PROGRAM OVERVIEW –

YouthBuild is a six month job training pre-apprentice program for youth ages 18-24. YouthBuild offers GED/HSD completion, case management support, job readiness training, and pre-apprenticeship training. Youth work on a 2 week rotating schedule; one week participating in GED/HSD completion and job readiness training, and the others learning construction skills in the shop. After students graduate they receive 9 months of follow-up from their case manager to continue to help support them in achieving their goals, including to place students in apprenticeship programs in the trades.

LOOKING FOR YOUTH WHO –

- Want to get their GED
- Are interested in living wage jobs in the Trades
- Are between 18 and 24 years of age
- And DOES NOT have a HSD or GED.
- Plus performance bonuses

YOUTHBUILD OFFERS-

- GED Preparation

SCHEDULE:

- Weekly schedule varies ranging from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday
- Mental Toughness - 2 weeks - physical and mental challenges; built to assess ability and willingness to participate.
- Shop Week(s) (7:45-3:00pm) – students are in the shop learning tool safety, proper use of tools, and construction skills.
- Education/JRT Week(s) (8:45am-3:30pm)– students spend half of their day studying for GED or HS completion and the other half receiving job readiness training lessons.

- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Low Income
- Seeking a GED (diploma and GED holders not eligible)
