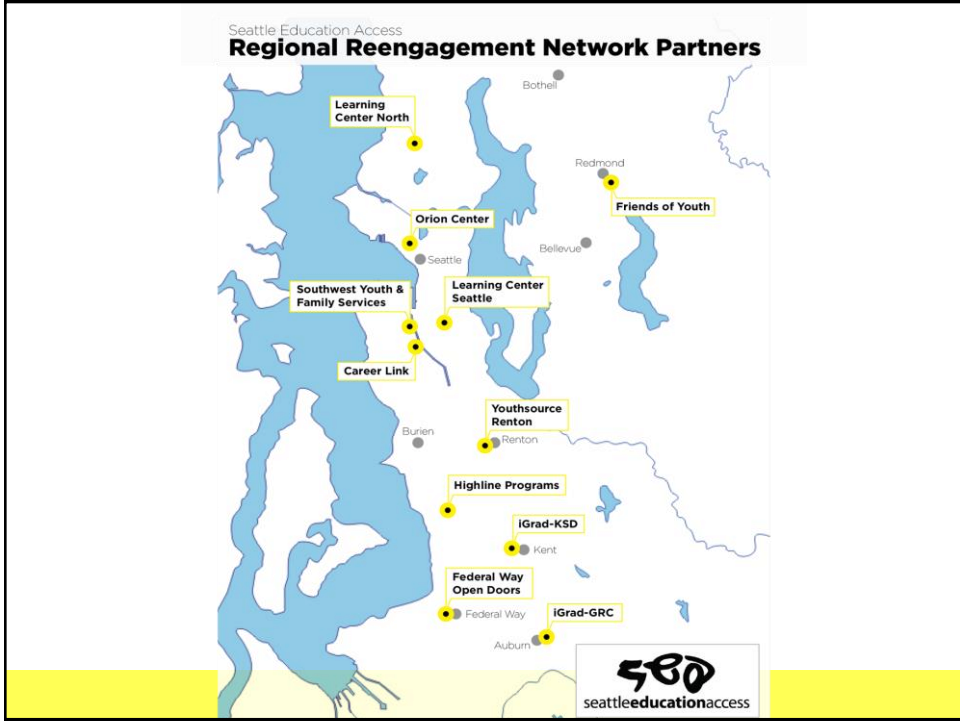

Student Demographics (SIF Students 2015 - 2016)

Of SEA's SIF-enrolled students served since 2015:

197 total students enrolled

39% have experienced homelessness

83% are 1st generation college attendees

51% are 1st generation HS/GED graduates

6% have been in foster care

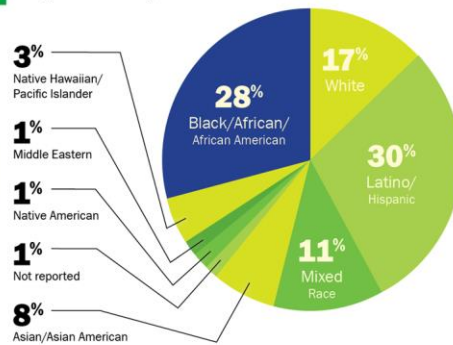
55% female **39%** male

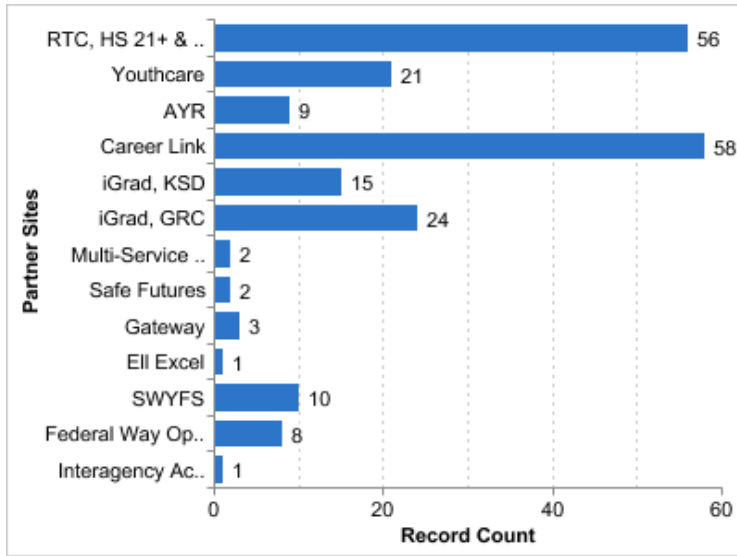
6% other

Where are our students coming from?

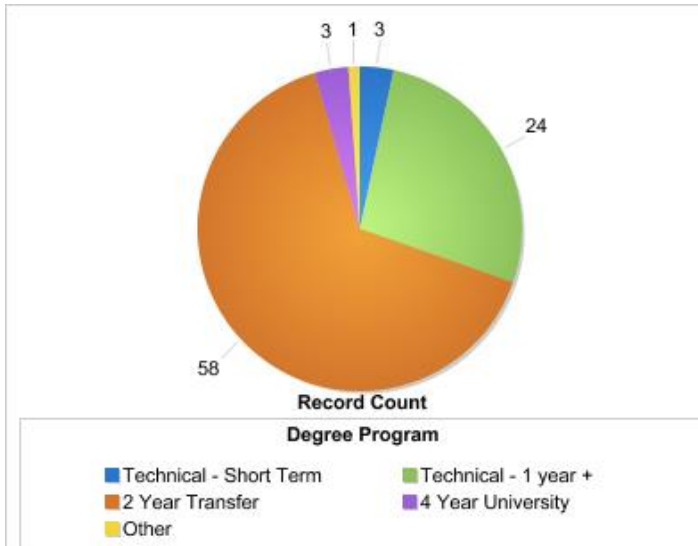
