PROGRAMS

Summer Employment - Out-of School

- 16– 24 years old, not attending school and low-income
- Wants to get to secure employment or attend college
- \$9.47 an hour paid internship placement

WIOA Out –of–School - Lives in King County

- 16– 24 years old, not attending school and low-income
- Wants to get a GED and secure employment or attend college
- \$11 an hour paid internship placement

WIOA In –School - Enrolled in the Seattle School District

- 16-21 years old and low –income
- Wants to get a GED/HSD & secure employment or attend college
- \$11 an hour paid I internship placement

Clear Path to Employment - Homeless in Seattle/King County

- 18– 25 years old
- Currently seeking employment
- \$11 an hour paid internship placement

WAGES - Homeless in the city limits of Seattle

- 18– 22 years old
- Currently seeking employment
- \$11 an hour paid internship placement

SYVPI - Lives in Central, SE or SW Seattle

- 14– 17 years old enrolled in the Initiative
- Receive \$600 stipend on completion of
