Health Workforce for the Future (HWF) is a project funded by a federal grant under Health & Human Services' Health Professions Opportunity Grant initiative (HPOG).

You may qualify if you...

- + Receive TANF, or
- + Have a household income at or below 200% of poverty level

Training...

- + Train for occupations in nursing, phlebotomy/lab, medical office and more!
- + Enroll in programs at community colleges and training institutions throughout King County
- + HWF may be able to cover all or part of training and other related costs
- + HWF staff provide support to help you successfully complete training and go to work

Additional program assistance includes...

- + Help deciding the right job/career for you
- + Help with training entrance exams
- + Academic support during training
- + Certification assistance
- + Job search support
